

WEDDING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Welcome your wedding guests to Upper Canada Village

Planning a wedding and looking for a unique locale to rent? Consider Christ Church at Upper Canada Village. Christ Church provides a special atmosphere for the enjoyment of your wedding party and guests.

Upper Canada Village, located 11 km east of Morrisburg, only 1-1/4 hours southeast of Ottawa and 1- 1/2 hours west of Montreal. Enjoy a unique locale for the wedding party and their guests to enjoy the special day.

CHRIST CHURCH WEDDING

Originally from the Lost Villages of Moulinette, but now a well know landmark within Upper Canada Village, Christ Church was built in 1837 in an aesthetic style know as Picturesque. Although the building reflects the sense of order, symmetry and balance that were the hallmarks of 18th century classicism, the pointed Gothic window arches and decorative trim on the tower add a romantic touch to the building, making it a delightful and charming historic setting for your special day.

- Christ Church is situated in Upper Canada Village, an 1860s setting which means that it has no lights. There is one electrical outlet available for the use of electrical equipment. Therefore, plan accordingly to enjoy daylight hours for your ceremony.
- The church can be rented between **May 21st and September 29th**. During the operating season weddings can take place before 9:30 a.m. or after 5:30 p.m.
- Please note that during the last two weeks of September set-up for Upper Canada Village's fall event Pumpkinferno takes place. During this time the site becomes a unique and artistic landscape of 6,000 hand-carved pumpkins which are lit for tours in the evening from 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. so take note of the fact that the event may be partially set-up during this time period.
- Christ Church can hold a maximum of 125 people (Covid19 protocols will be followed).
- Rental cost for the church is \$825.00 (*plus HST*) for the church rental only. It is your responsibility for all other preparations such as flowers, minister, dresses and clean-up after the ceremony. Please designate one person to begin removing all items from the Church as soon as the ceremony/Church photos conclude so that the Church can be locked.
- Candles are **not** permitted. The use of rose petals, rice or confetti is also **not** permitted. Water is not permitted in flower vases. Food and drink is not permitted inside the building (only water in bottles that can be closed).
- Floral décor is permitted with limited use of elastic bands or string to fix arrangements in place. *No tacks or tape are permitted.*
- It is your responsibility to co-ordinate the church service music.



Note: Cars are not permitted in the Village.

Historical transportation rentals

- A horse, carriage and driver are available for one hour for a fee of \$300.00 (plus HST).
- For a fee of \$300.00, the horse drawn carry-all is available to transport your guests (20 to 25 guests) from the parking lot to the church (and back only if time permits).

Cancellation policy:

- A written cancellation must be received 14 days prior to the scheduled event.
- The rental fee is refundable if cancellation is received 14 days prior to the scheduled event.
- 50% of the rental fee will be forfeited if cancellation is made within 14 days of the scheduled event.
